1.INTRODUCTION

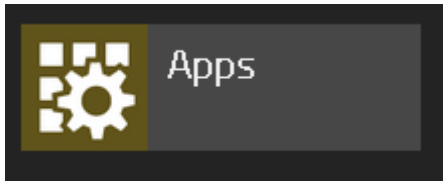
Sites Manager is an application that allows you to centrally and easily manage access to a company's corporate applications (ERP, CRM, other information systems, etc.)

All links -URLs- to corporate applications are managed centrally from Sites Manager. The administrator configures for each user the applications to which they've access and in this way the user from myapps can access them in a comfortable and simple way.


2.INSTALATION FROM INNOVAPHONE APP STORE

Go to **Apps**.

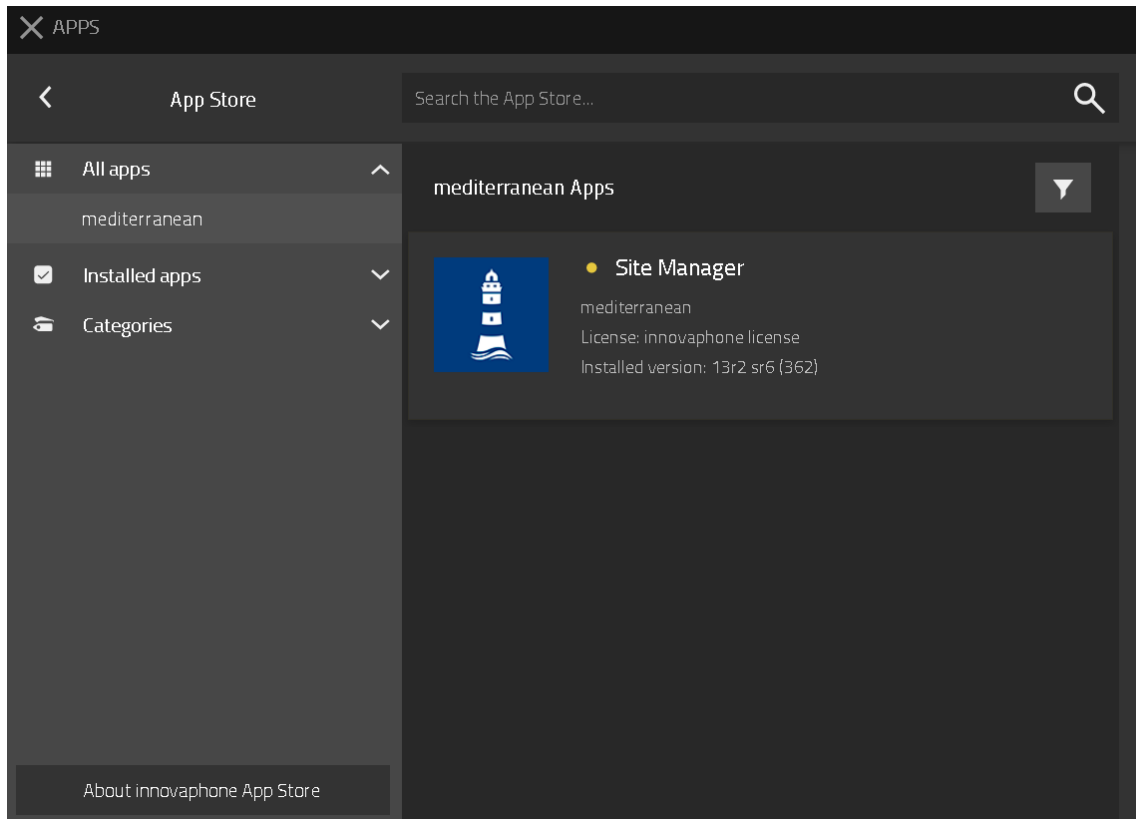


Go to **App Store**.

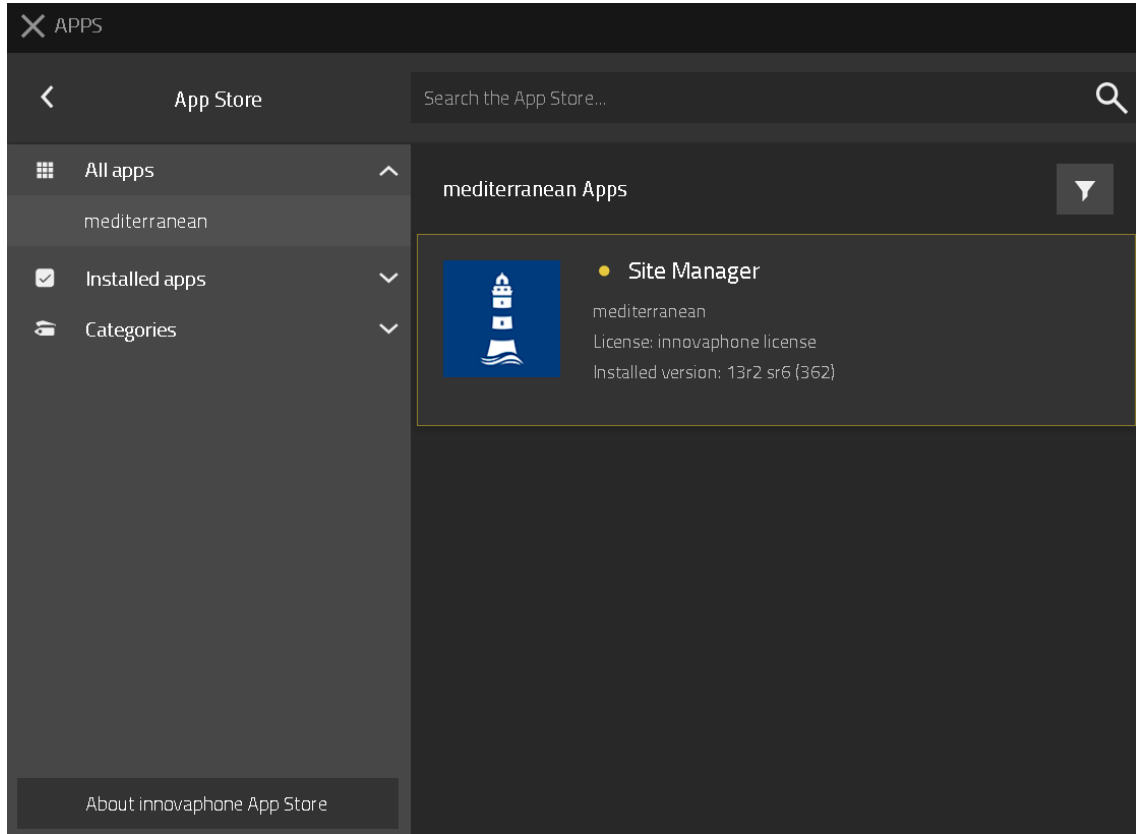

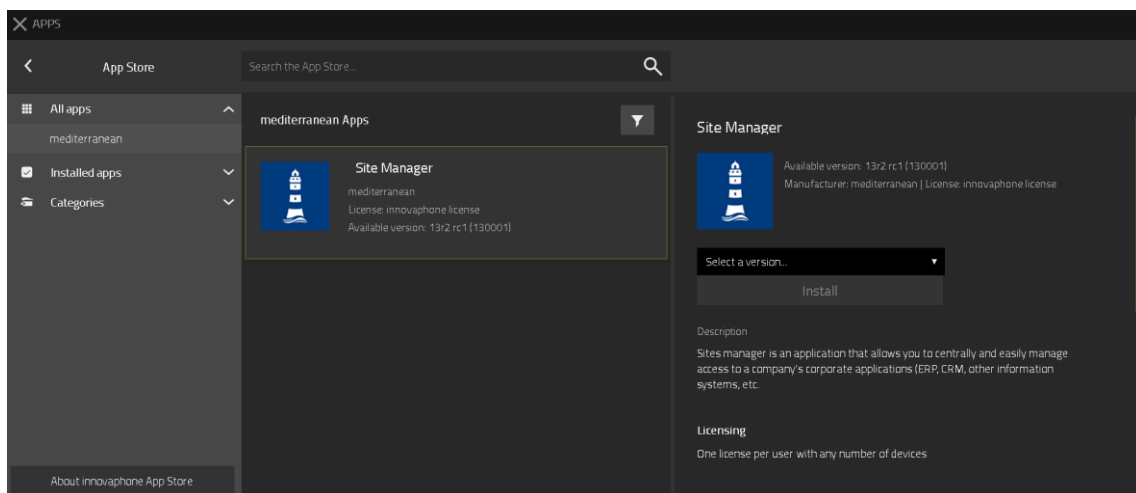
Select the manufacturer of the App.



Select the App.

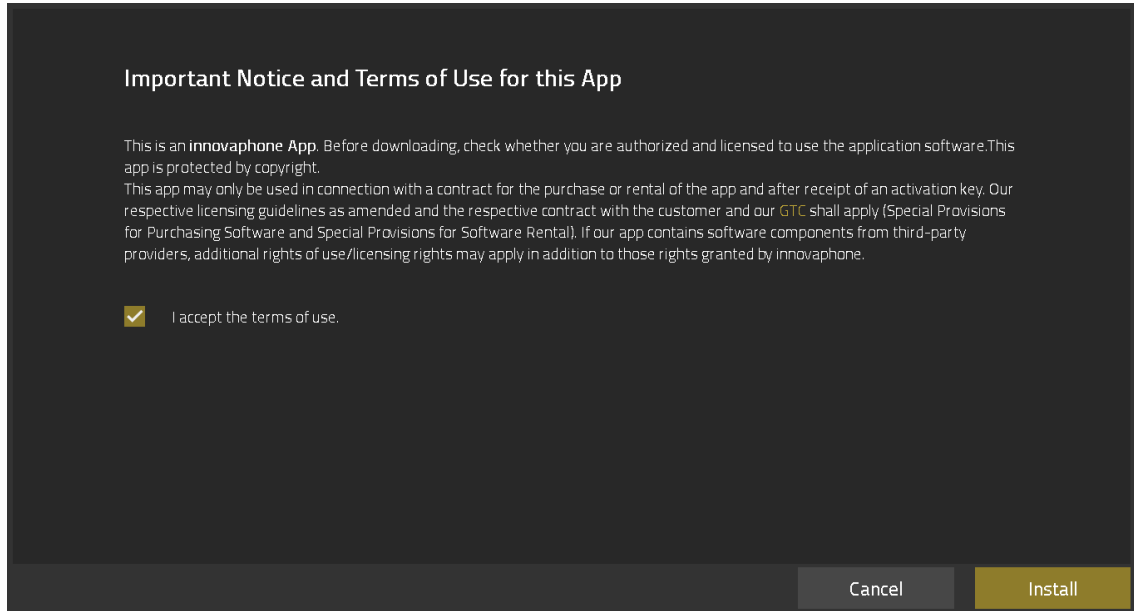


Select the version you want to install.



Click on the Install button.

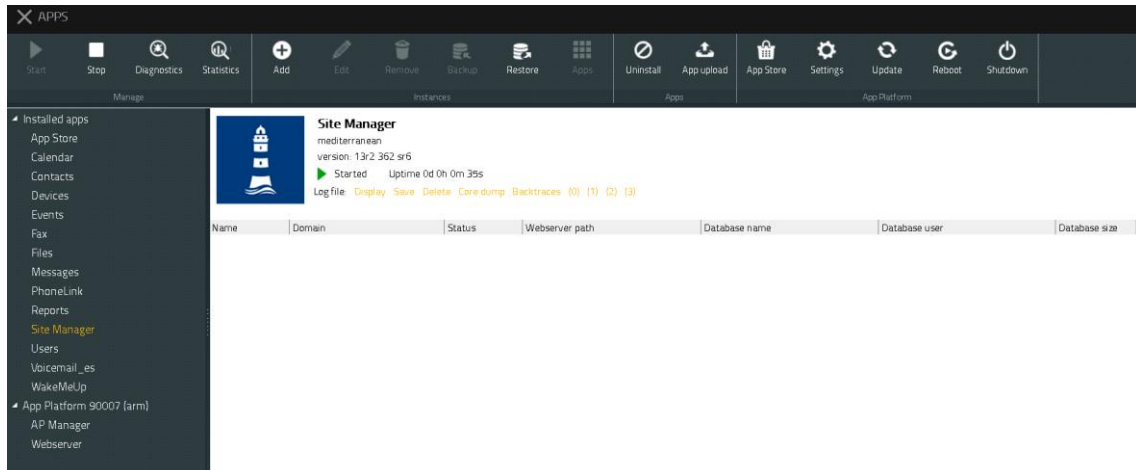
The acceptance of terms of use check is marked.



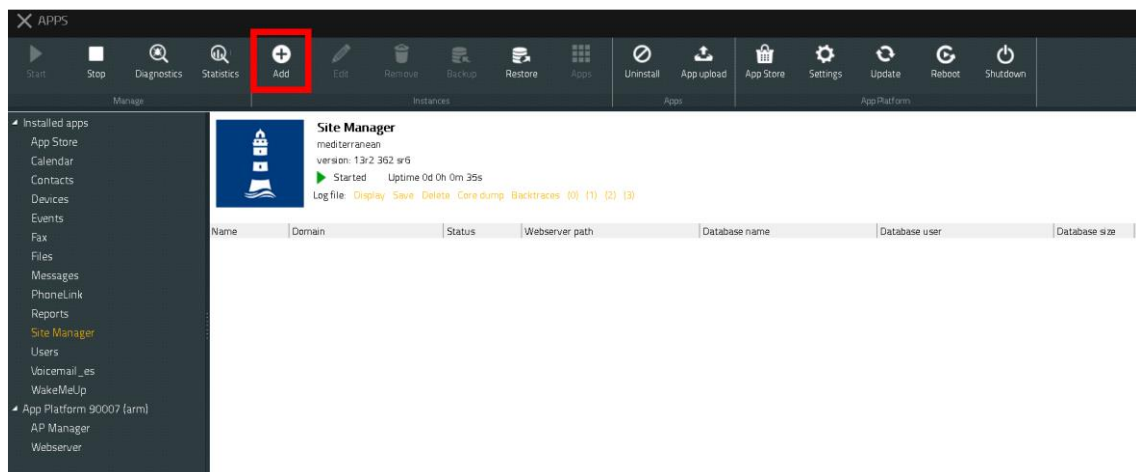
And click on the Install button.

3. INSTANCE CONFIGURATION


Once the App has been installed, it is observed that there is no instance.



An instance is created by using the **Add** button.




The fields are filled in to create the instance.



And the **Save** button is clicked.

It can be seen that the instance has been created.

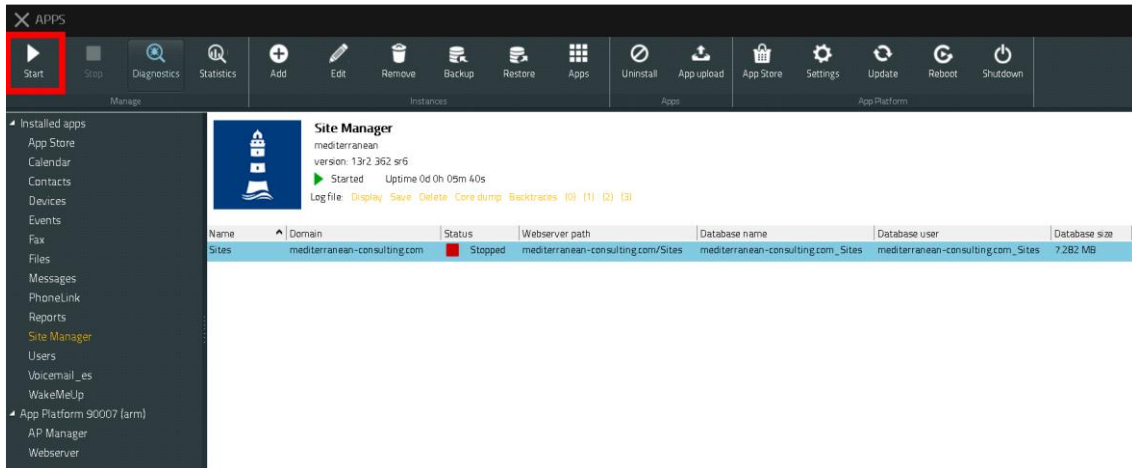

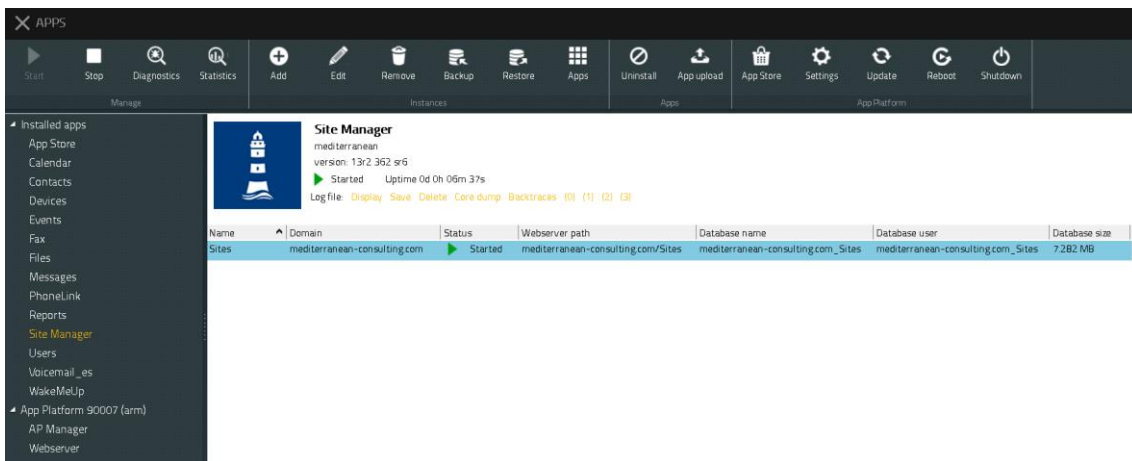
Now it is necessary to put the App into operation.

To do this, the instance that has just been created is selected.

And by means of the **Start** button, the App is started.



In the following image you can see that the App is working.



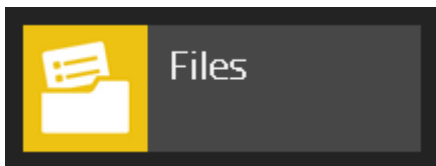
4.APP SITES CONFIGURATION

For the App to work properly, you have to configure the **Sites Manager** and the **Sites** you want to access.

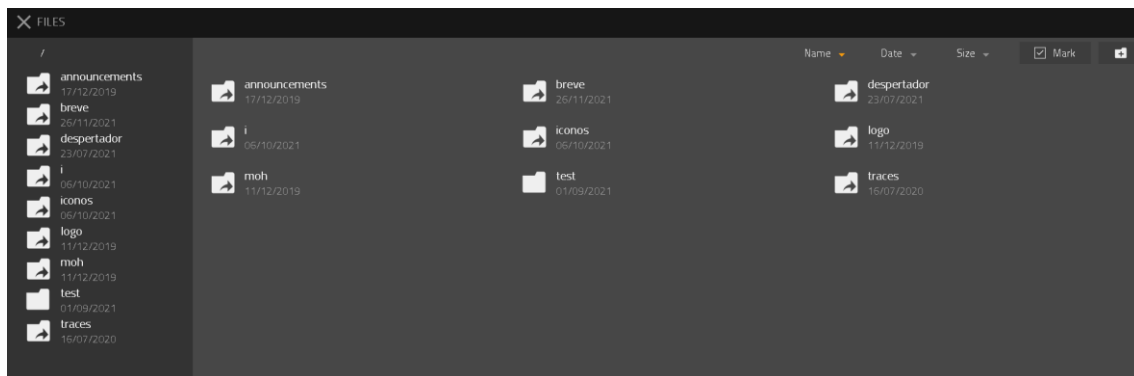
The **Sites** can have custom icons, which must be uploaded to the **App Files**.

4.1 LOADING ICONS


To load the icons, you must go to the **App Files**.



The App opens and the directory that will contain the icons is created.




The icons directory is created and access is configured by user and password.



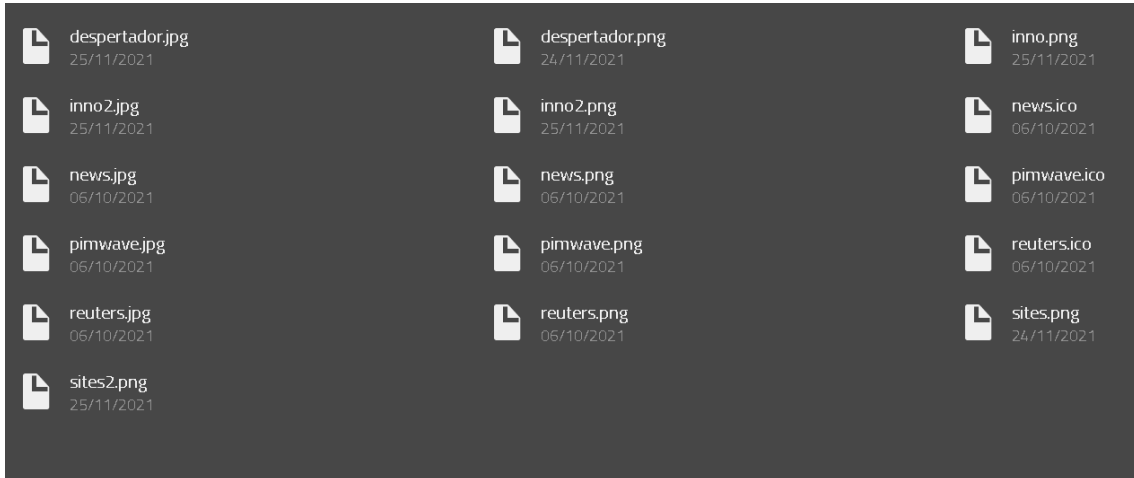

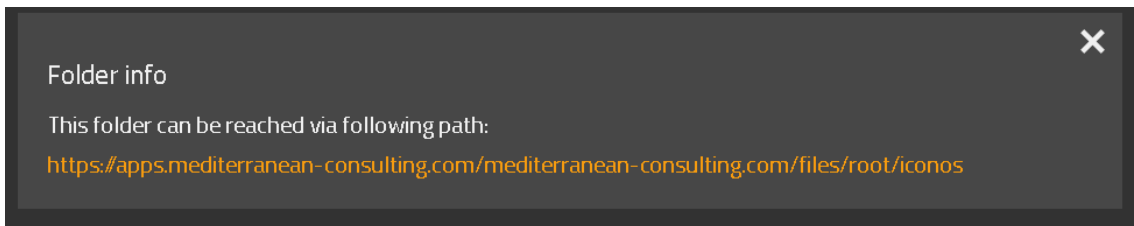

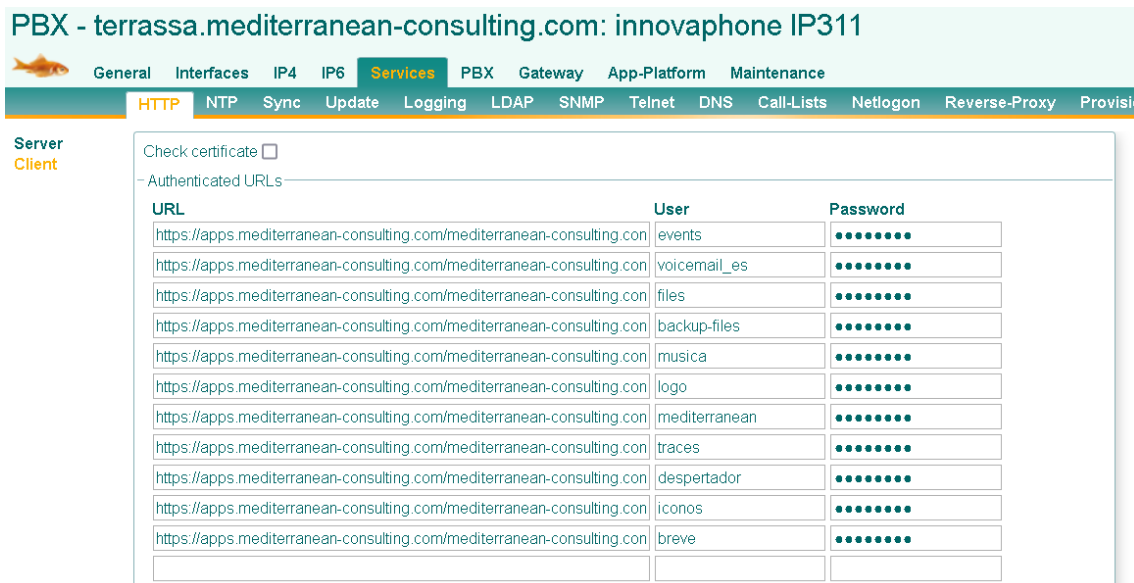
The icons are loaded.



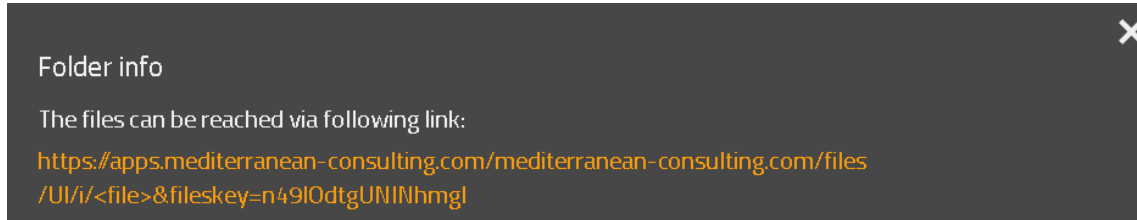
Once the user name, password have been assigned and the icons have been loaded, the path of the link is copied to access the icons folder.



If username and password are used, go to **Services-HPPT-Client** on the **PBX** and declare the path, username and password.



If filecode access is used, it is not required.



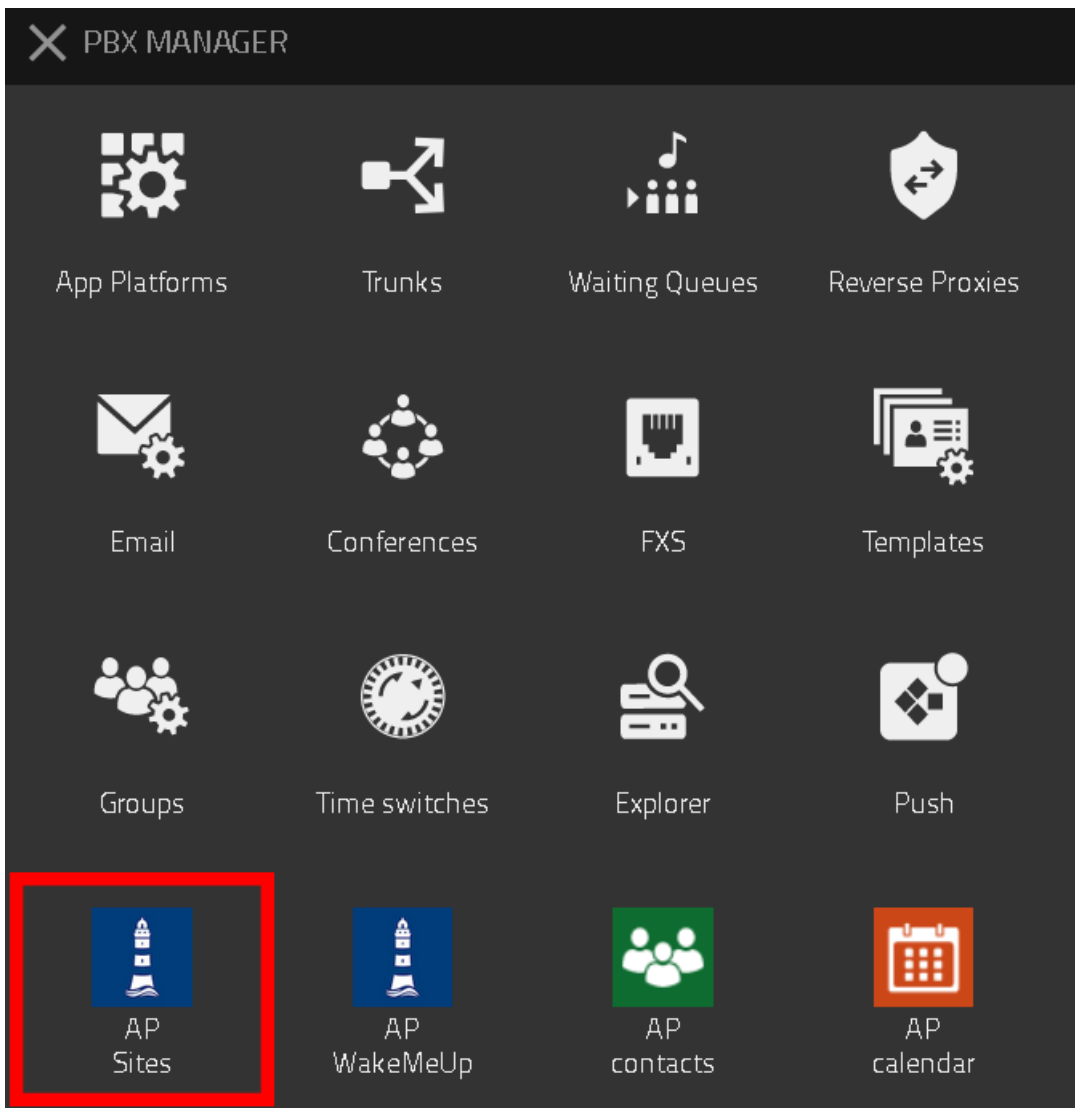
The name of the route is taken and it is modified for each particular icon.

4.2 SITES MANAGER CONFIGURATION

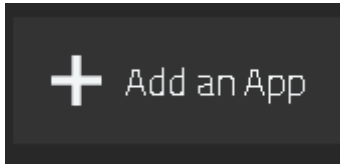
To configure the **Sites Manager** you must go to **PBX Manager**.



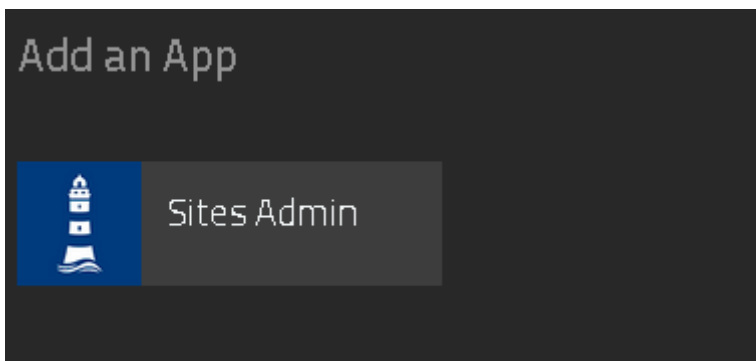
When you open the **PBX Manager**, you see **AP Sites**.



If App Sites is selected, the + **Add an App** button appears.



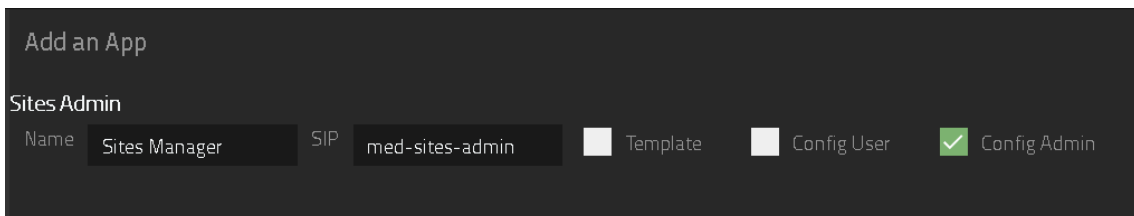
By clicking on this button you can select to create the **Sites Manager** or create a **Site**.



Click on the **Sites Manager** button.



And the **Sites Manager** is configured.

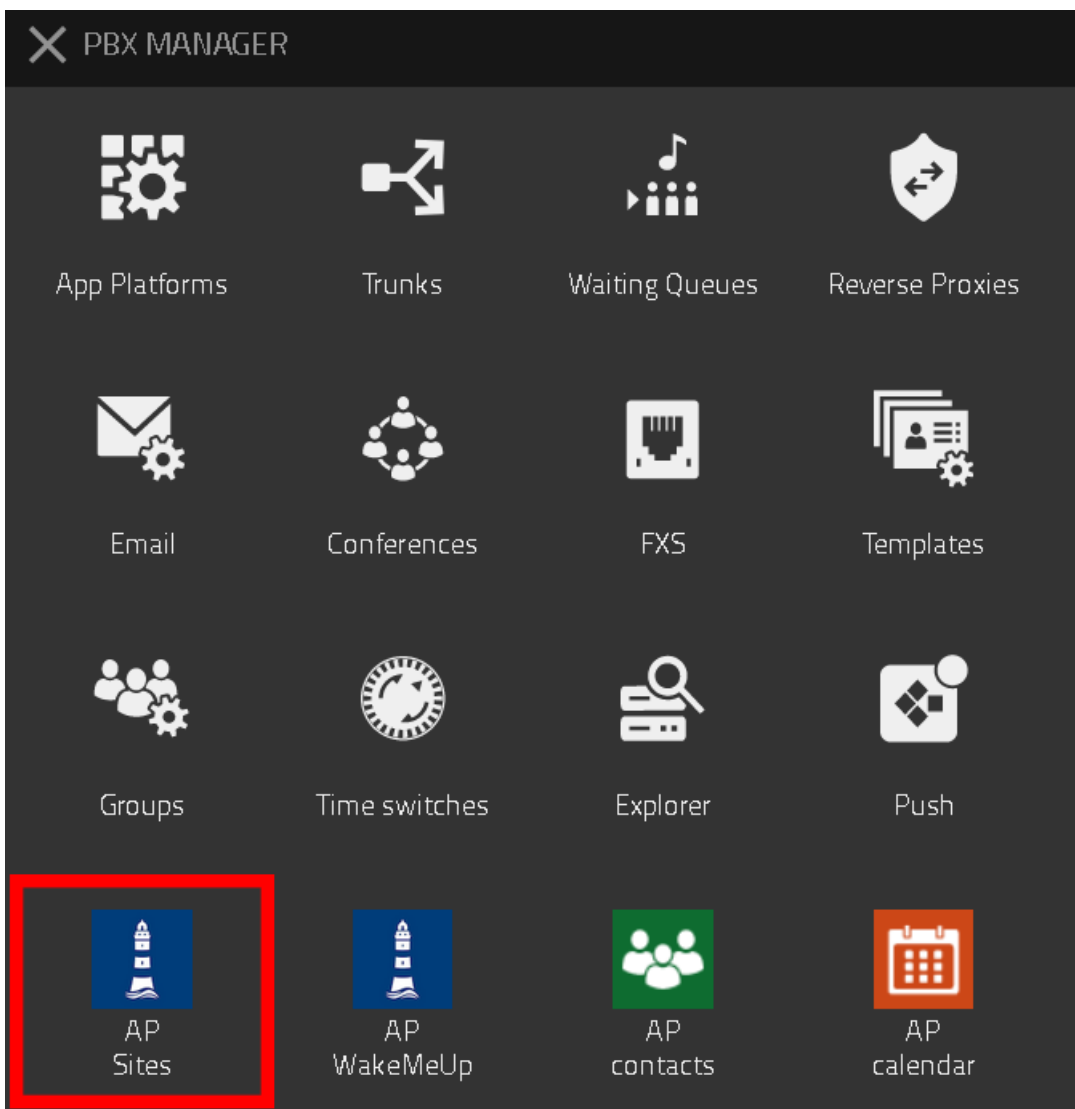


4.3 SITES CONFIGURATION

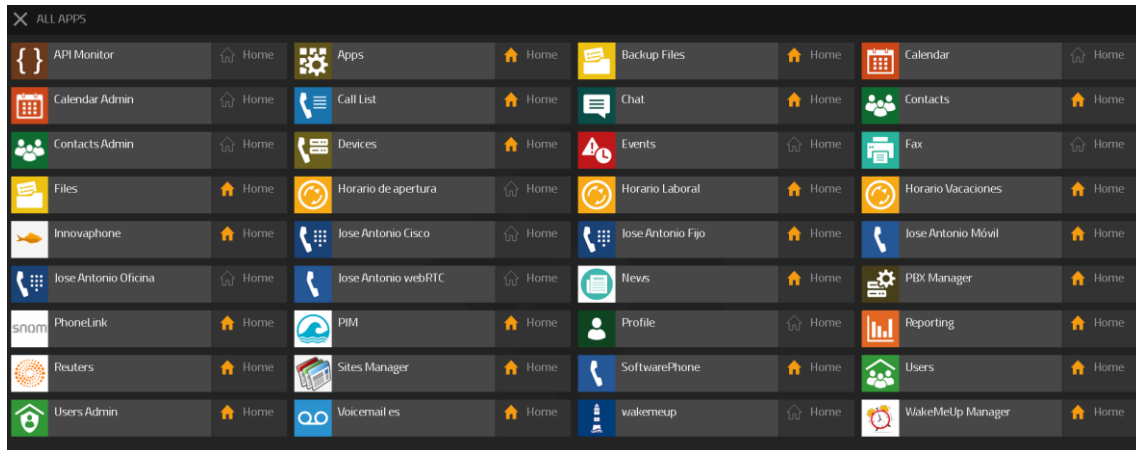
To configure **Sites** you must go to the **PBX Manager**.



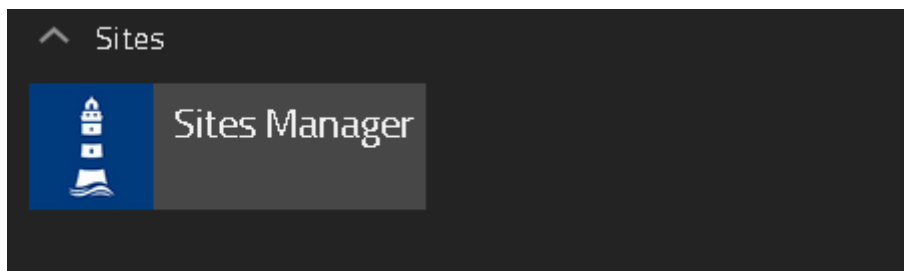
When you open the **PBX Manager**, you see **AP Sites**.



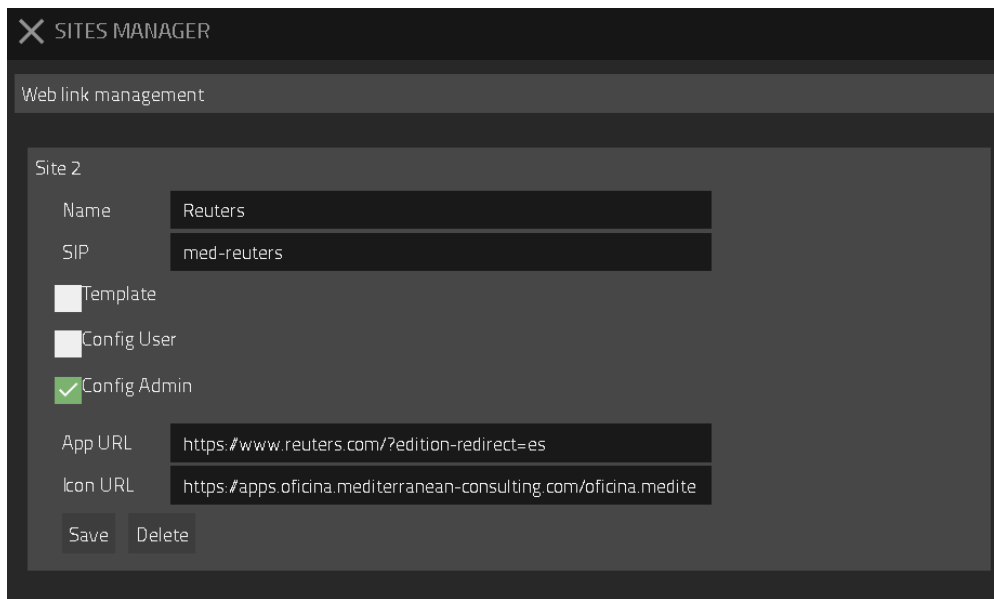
You can then go to the **Myapps All Apps** screen and select the **Sites Manager**.



And group them on the **Home** screen of **Myapps**.



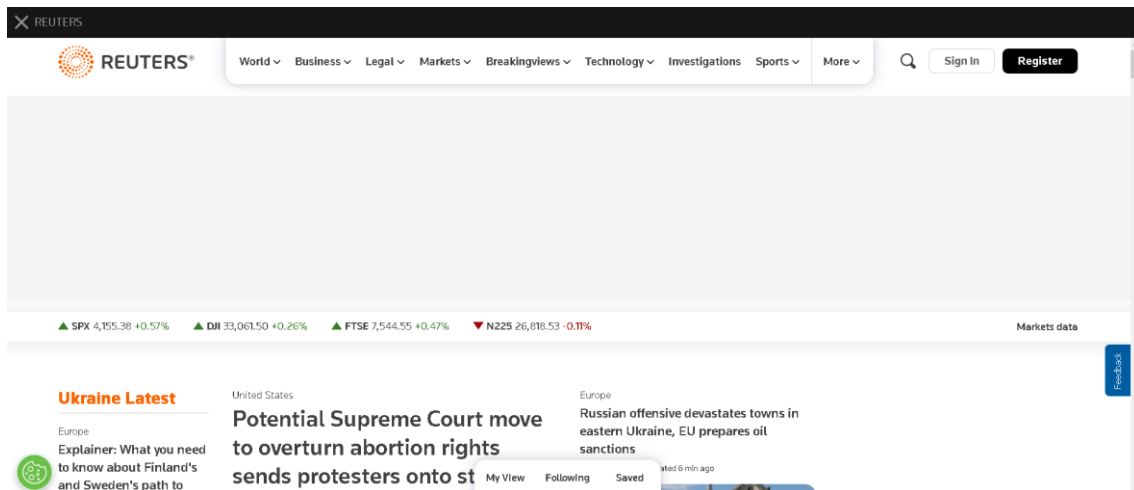
For the links to work properly, you must enter **Sites Manager** and indicate the url of each **Site** button.



As can be seen, in **App** you must indicate the name that was given to the **Site**, the URL and the icon.

The URLs indicated must be https, if http URLs are indicated, it may not work.

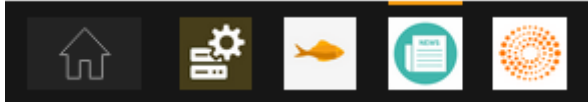
If a site opens.



You can navigate through it.

If the embedded web page has any links or menu items that are intended to be in an additional browser or tab, they will also be opened from sites and navigation from that point will be external to sites, as if the page had been opened from a browser directly.

And at the bottom of myapps you can browse the Apps or Open Sites.
